



The castle has 14 king-size en suite bedrooms, stunning drawing room and dining room, breakfast room, library, snooker room, tasting room, whisky vault and tower room. Set within 11 acres of picturesque grounds with an idyllic lochan, there are outdoor terraces, heated kennels and sporting rooms to ensure you can enjoy the very best of Speyside.

You will be treated to the utmost care and attention by our dedicated team. Indulge in a dining experience like no other, led by our awardwinning chef who crafts culinary masterpieces using local, seasonal ingredients. 
